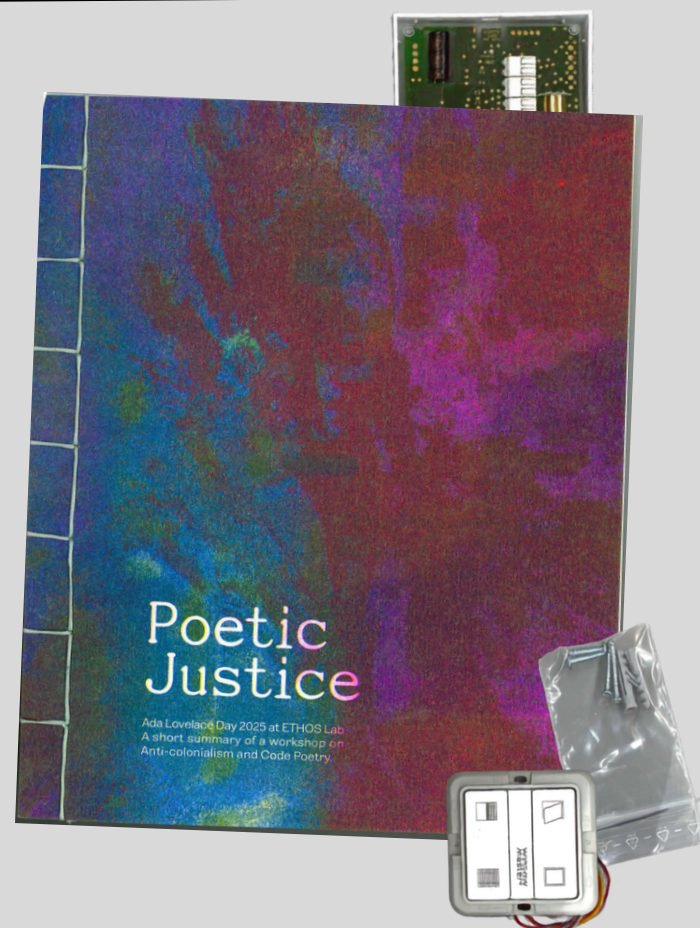

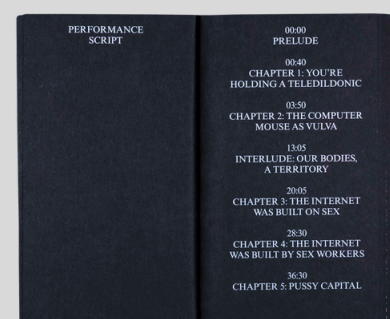


Two hotttt tips!
